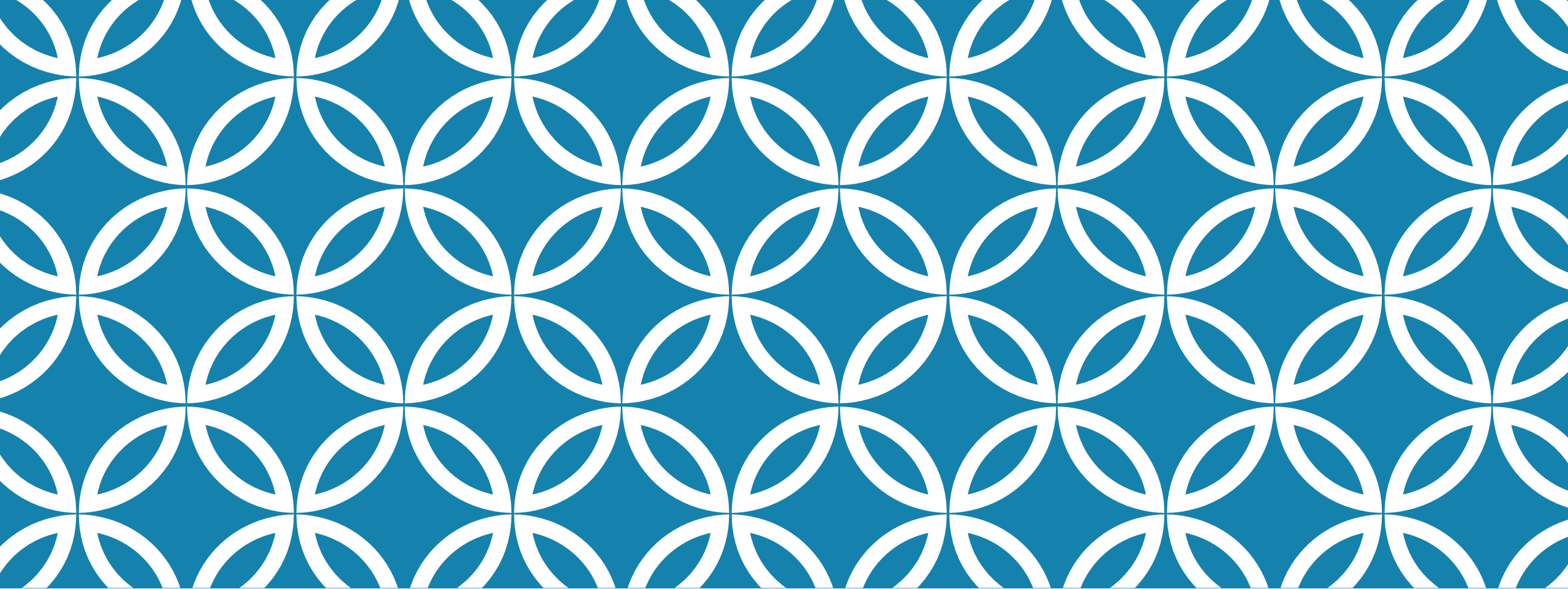

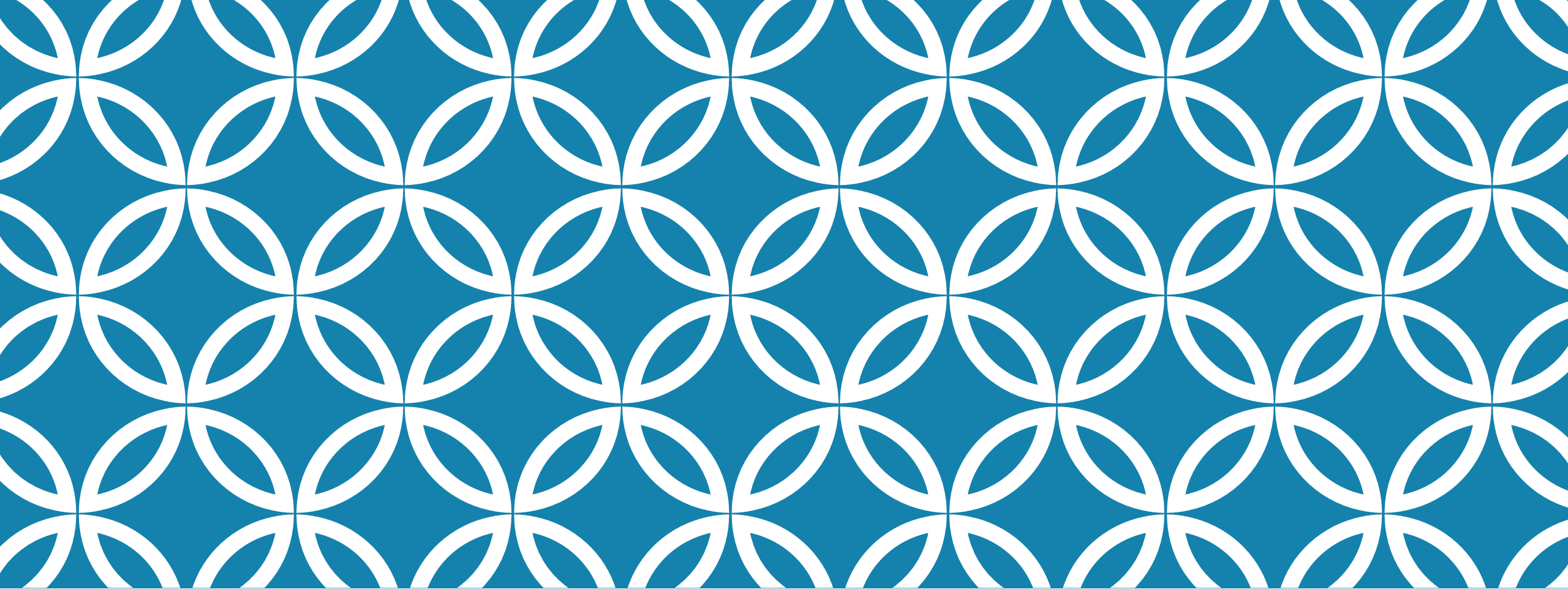

# JESUS CHRIST REVEALED

<sup>1</sup> That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

<sup>2</sup> (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

<sup>3</sup> That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

# ETERNAL PRE- EXISTENT CHRIST

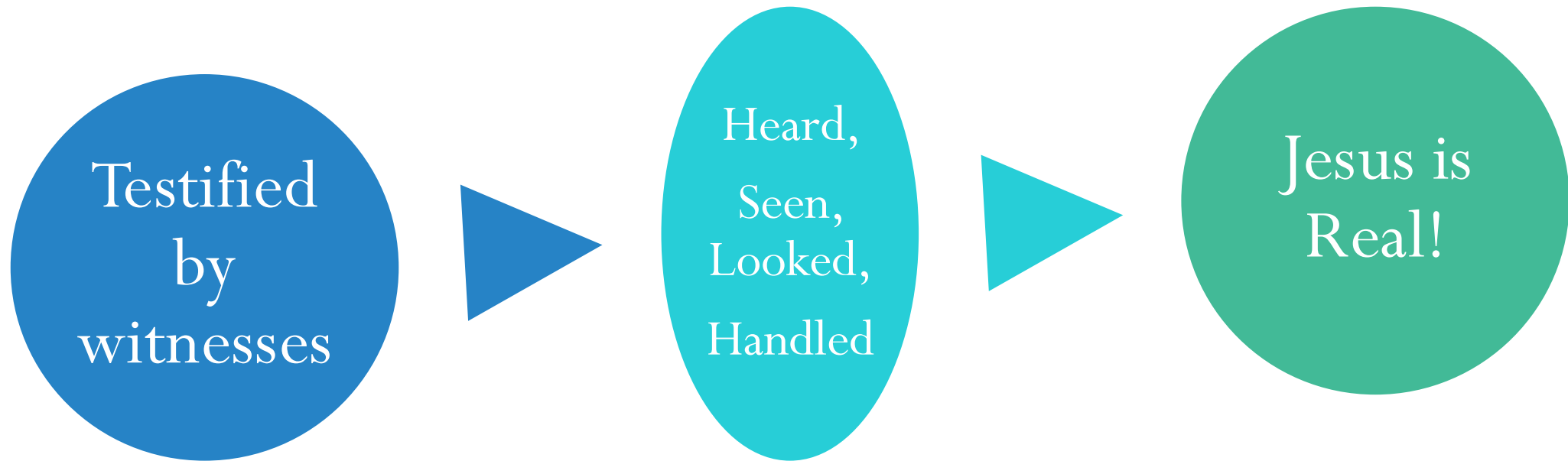
**Psalm 90:2** Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God.

# INCARNATION

**Galatians 4:4** But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

**Mathew 1:16** And Jacob begat Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, who is called Christ.

# HEARD

Disciples **heard** directly from Jesus (for example, sermon on the mount)

Source: Truth received by Jesus from God.

John 7:<sup>16</sup> Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.

What is the source of our truth?

# SEEN

**John 1:14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

**John 12:20** And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast: <sup>21</sup> The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.

# LOOKED UPON

LOOKED UPON (studied, gazed intently, focused)

**Jeremiah 9:24** But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the Lord which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the Lord.

**Philippians 3:10** That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;



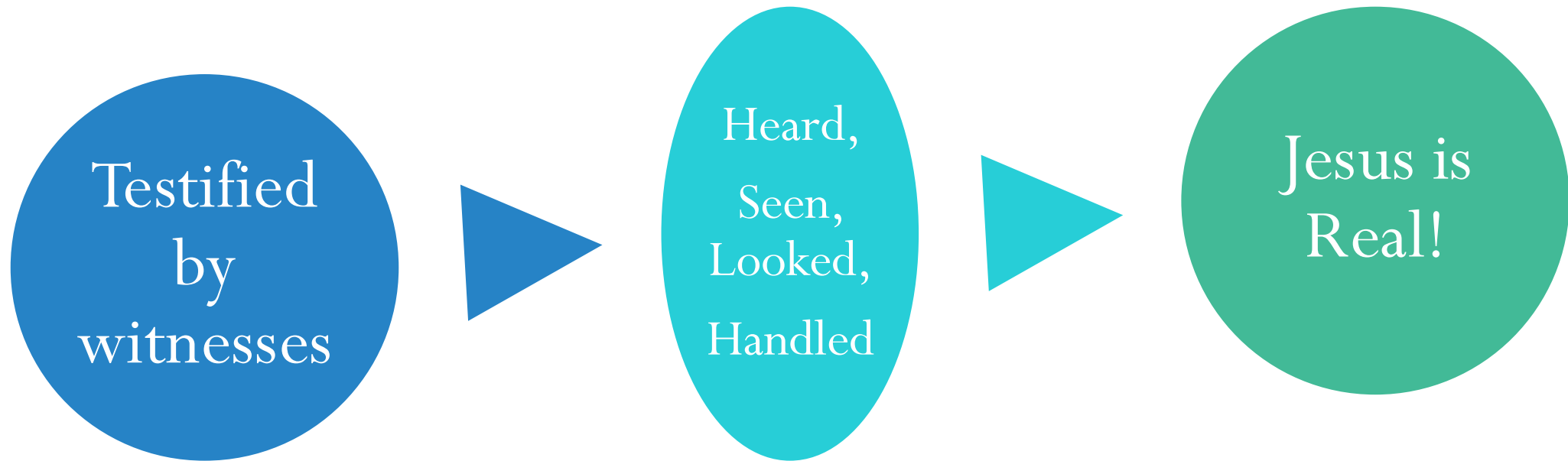
# OUR HANDS HAVE HANDLED (TOUCHED)

**Luke 24:39** Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

**John 20:27** Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

## WORD OF LIFE

Jesus Christ is **THE WORD** (God communicated His message through Christ)

and **THE WORD OF LIFE** (the communication of God's word brought life)

Jesus ...I am the way, the truth, and the life! (John 14:6)

Manifested . . . made flesh

Witnessed and shared with others

**1 Timothy 3:16** And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

## PURPOSE OF DECLARATION

<sup>3</sup> THAT WHICH WE  
HAVE SEEN AND  
HEARD DECLARE WE  
UNTO YOU, THAT YE  
ALSO MAY HAVE  
FELLOWSHIP WITH US:  
AND TRULY OUR  
FELLOWSHIP IS WITH  
THE FATHER, AND  
WITH HIS SON JESUS  
CHRIST.

Declaration/Witness: of what is seen and heard. We cannot truthfully witness if we have not seen/heard/experienced.

**WHY:** May enjoy gift of **fellowship** (supernatural fellowship/communion among believers through Christ)

Tri-fold Fellowship: with God the Father, Jesus, and other believers

# FELLOWSHIP IS THE WORK OF THE SPIRIT

Physical interaction does not produce fellowship (ex. Judas Iscariot)

Friendship is natural but **FELLOWSHIP** is the supernatural work of the spirit among the body of believers.

The indwelling spirit connects us to other believers supernaturally ... a bond that is stronger than blood relations.

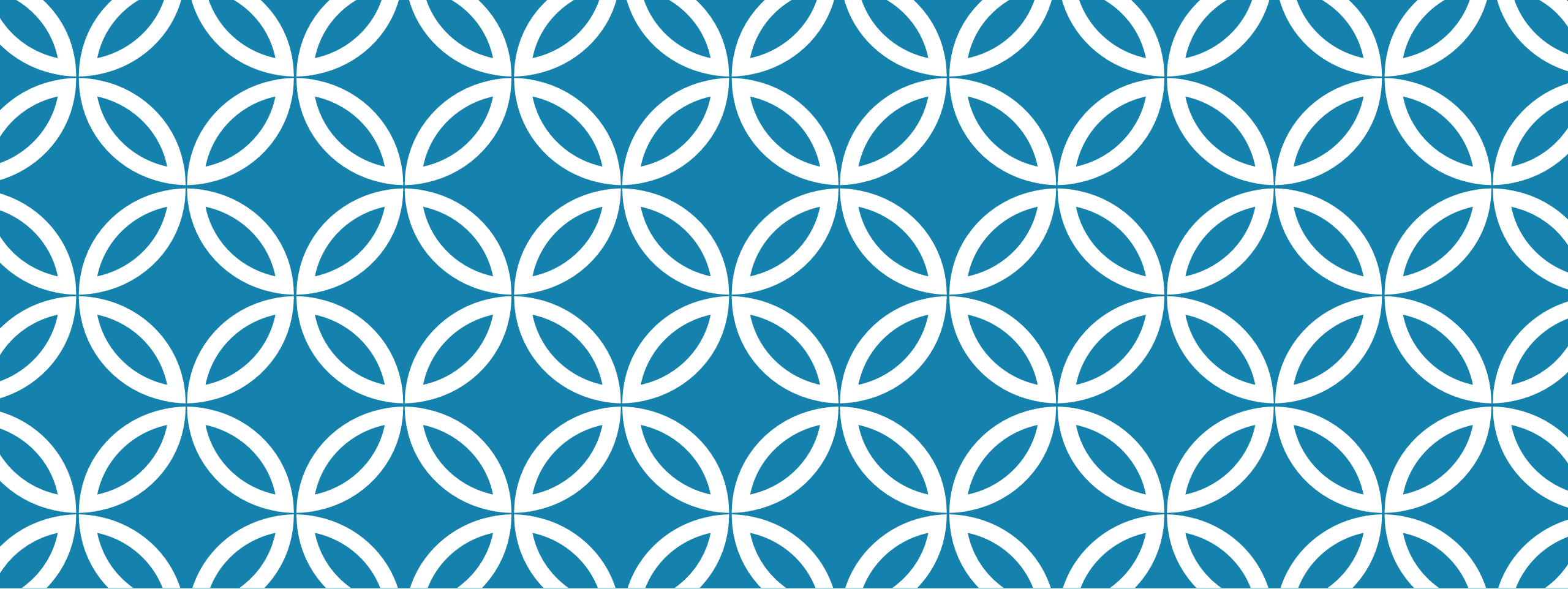
# FELLOWSHIP IS THE WORK OF THE SPIRIT

**John 14:9** Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

Church attendance, knowledge, good works etc. do not produce relationship with God

Romans 8:9 Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

# FULLNESS OF JOY

**John 15:11** These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

**John 16:24** Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

**John 17:13** And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

# LASTING JOY

Joy begins with Repentance

and is sustained with His Presence/Fellowship

**Repentance** (Luke 15:7 that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth)

**Fellowship with God** (I John 1:3-4) In thy presence is fulness of joy (Psalms 16:11)

# REPENTANCE

ACTS 26:20  
...THAT THEY  
SHOULD  
REPENT AND  
TURN TO GOD,  
AND DO WORKS  
MEET FOR  
REPENTANCE

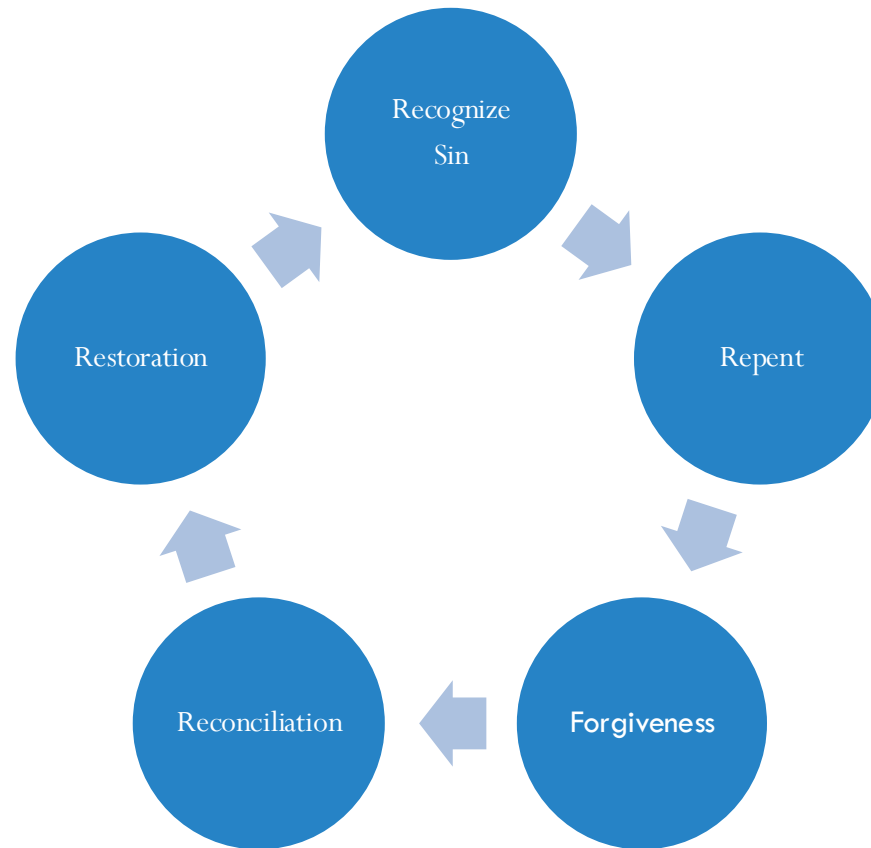
Is more than being “Sorry” and “Regretting” for mistakes made.

**Repentance** requires turning away from sin and turning to God.

Repentance is not the work of man but work of God (John 6:<sup>44</sup> No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him). How does God draw us to Him?

Repentance is followed by change (Mathew 3:8, fruits meet for repentance, II Corinthians 5:17, old things are passed away)

# BELIEVERS FALLING INTO SIN: REPENTANCE IS THE KEY TO RESTORATION (EX. PRODIGAL SON)



BELIEVER'S  
GOAL:

**Psalm 51:12** Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation.

**Unrepentant believer lives in misery**

Psalm 32, <sup>3</sup> When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long. <sup>4</sup> For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me: my moisture is turned into the drought of summer.



# FELLOWSHIP

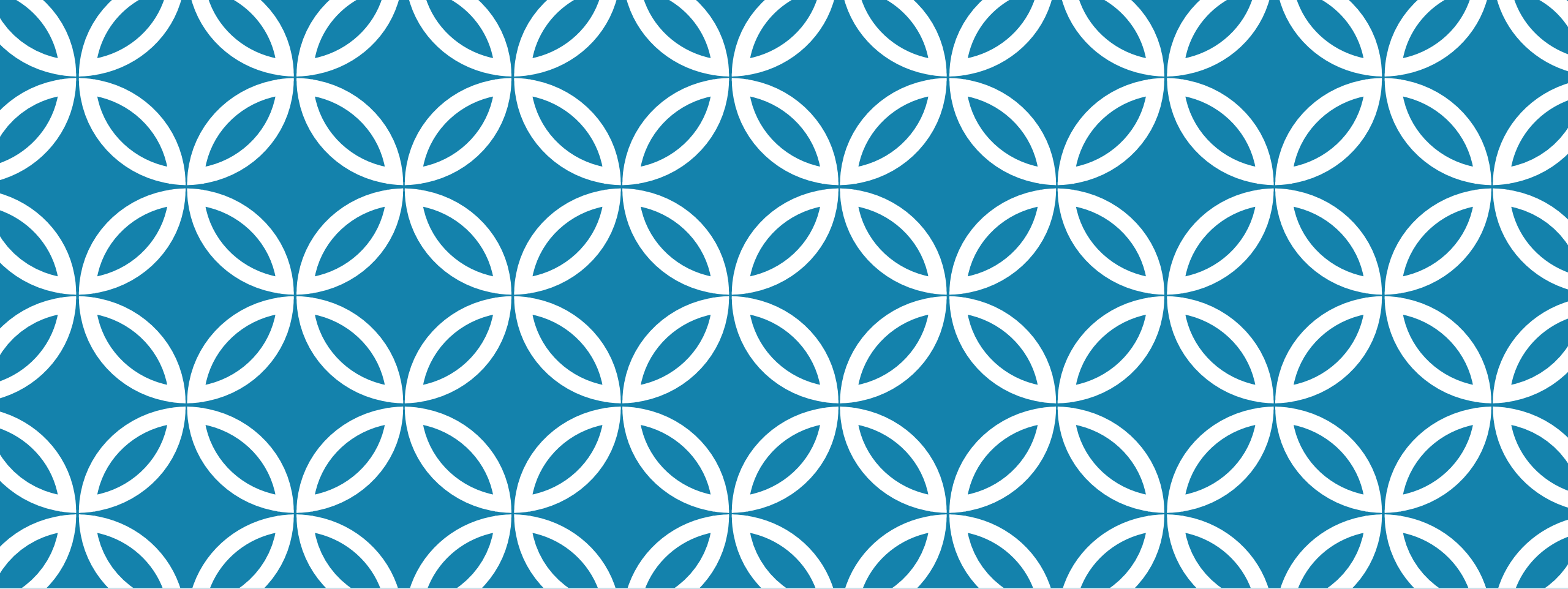
Being steadfast in WORD + PRAYER + COMMUNION (ACTS 2:42) will enhance our FELLOWSHIP with God and others.

## Hindrance to fellowship

Worldly friendships James 4:4 ... know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

## Unconfessed sin

+ not submitting to God's will in all areas of our life (be it our work, education, families, or pursuit of success)


