

- Sin: Lying/Deception/Hypocrisy (Pretended to have given it all!)
 - Spirit of lying began in the garden and continues today ... Devil is a liar and father of it (John 8:44), Lord detests lying lips (Proverbs 12:22) Lord hates hypocrisy (Matthew 6:1-4, 15: 7-9, 23:27-28), Do not lie to each other (Colossians 3:9) liars will be found outside the Kingdom (Revelation 22:15)
- Motive: Self-righteousness/public recognition and praise. But God looks at our heart (I Samuel 16:7) ... Our audience should be God and not people!
- Sinned against God (verse 4) ... all sins are first, against God
 - Against You, You only, have I sinned ... (David, Psalms 51:4) (I Thessalonians 4:8)

How?: Through discernment and the Holy Spirit (I Corinthians 12:8, spirit of knowledge and wisdom)

Discipline: Public rebuke that lead to death (4/5, 9/10)

Outcome: Great fear in church (5/11) (great power and great grace in 4:33)

* Church mentioned for the first time in Acts 5:11

Why is discipline necessary in the church? Is it practiced today?

e. Why is discipline necessary in the church? Is it practiced today?

- It is the will of God to maintain discipline in church
- To avoid decay (I Corinthians 5:6) and death of church
- To keep the church pure (Ephesians 5:25-27)
- To restore fallen believers (Galatians 6:1)
- To experience continued victories (Joshua 7)
- To be an effective testimony to outsiders (II Samuel 12:14-example of bad witness)

• Sapphira means 'Beautiful' in Aramaic

Ananias means 'God is gracious' in Hebrew

f. Were they filled with the spirit in 4: 31? g. Will A&S be in heaven?

f. Yes (contrast, 4:31 and 5:3)

Their changed behavior shows the need for "continual filling"

- "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" (Jeremiah 17:9) "Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall" (I Corinthians 10:12)
- g. physical death does not imply spiritual death (I Corinthians 5:5)(I John 5:17)

- More blessed to Give (Acts 20:35)
- Give Cheerfully (II Corinthians 9:7)
- Give Secretly (Mathew 6:3, 4)
- Give Sacrificially (II Samuel 24:24)
- Promise: If we give prayerfully with the right spirit, we will not lack (Luke 6:38, Matthew 6:4, Malachi 3:10, Psalms 37:25, Mathew 6:33)


- a. Why were some hesitant to join the church? (13)

 Maybe because of the high calling of the church/Spiritual discipline
- b. What was the impact of miracles?

Multitude of believers added "to the Lord" (14) Word spreads beyond Jerusalem;

c. Was everyone healed? Does shadow of great man of God have power to heal?

Yes, everyone healed (16) God does complete work (with 5 loaves and 2 fishes, all were fed! It is finished!)

- a. Why were they imprisoned? What was the surprising message of Angels? What is the message of life?(19-21, 25)
- a. Second imprisonment in common prison (1^{st} one in Acts 4:3) ... imprisoned for witnessing about Jesus (v. 17/18)

b. Angels

- a. Delivered them from Prison
- b. Message ... to return to Temple and Preach about life
- c. Life ... Repentance that leads to Eternal life (Acts 11:18)
 - God is the creator of life (Genesis 2:7, John 1:3.4), giver of everlasting life (John 3:16), giver of abundant life (John 10:10), destroyer of life (Revelation 20:15)

Angels ... few verses about angels

- Created by God (Colossians 1:16)
- Ministering spirits (Hebrews 1:14)
- Rejoice at our salvation (Luke 15:10)
- Messengers (John 20:11-12, Revelation 14:6)
- Save (Psalms 91:11, Daniel 6:22), Sustain (Mathew 4:11) and Destroy (Psalms 78:49)
- Worshippers in Heaven (Hebrews 12:22, Revelation 4:8, 5:11-12)
- Sinning angels are punished (Isaiah 14:12, II Peter 2:4, Jude 1:6)
- Will return with the Lord (Mathew 16:27)

b. What was Peter's response to council? (26-29)

b. What was Peter's response to council? (26-29)

- v.26 Arrested again
- v.27 Second hearing before the council
- v.28 Second warning/threat

 Effectiveness of apostles witness (Jerusalem filled with their teachings!)
- v.29 Peter's Response did not change (Acts 4:19-20) (WE OUGHT TO OBEY GOD RATHER THAN MEN)
 - As persecution increases, our faith should not weaken neither should our response change

c. What was Peter's message (30-32)

• Similar to Message #1 (ch.2), Message #2 (Ch.3), Message #3 (ch.4)

 Message (JESUS): Jesus crucified by Jews, Raised by God the Father, Exalted by God, path to repentance and forgiveness of sins, and we are His witnesses

• ... gospel message is the most important message!

• Tree: Deuteronomy 21:22-23 (Jewish) (Cross: Romans)

- d. What was the impact of the message (33)? e. Who was Gamaliel and what was his suggestion(34-39)?
- d. "cut to the heart, and took counsel to slay them" (v.33) ... is it the same as "pricked in their heart (2:37)"?

- e. Gamaliel Senior Rabbi, A Pharisee (member of the council)
 - If it be their own work, it will die a natural death;
 - if it is from God, no one can stop it (no one can fight God and win!)

- f. What was apostles response to beating (40-41), g. Did the Lord's work suffer because of persecution? (42) h. How can we endure persecution?
- Reason for Joy: "They departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were considered worthy to suffer shame for his name" (v.41)
- "... they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ" (v.42)
- * blessed are the persecuted, Mathew 5:10-12, I Peter 3:14, II Peter 4:14

The Great Commission continued, despite Persecution ... Praise God!

Important themes/moral lessons/application

REVELATION + APPLICATION = TRANSFORMATION

James 1:22 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.
