


The NEW MAN behaves differently (Ephesians 4): What's your score? Maximum = 9





Wine in the Bible

Permitted

Healing Properties of wine

- Proverbs 31:6 (heavy hearted)
- I Timothy 5:23 (medicine)

Cultural context

- Jesus 1st miracle (water into wine)
- Celebration (Isaiah 25:6)
- Blessing of Isaac (Genesis 27:28)

NOT advisable

- Leads to addiction, loss of control, yield to temptations (Proverbs 23:29-35)
- Foolish (Proverbs 20:1, Hosea 4:11) Woes (Isaiah 5:22) leads to poverty (Proverbs 21:17)
- Affects our testimony and may become stumbling block for others (Romans 14:13, I Corinthians 6:12, 8:9, 10:31)
