Paul's imprisonment and title (1)

Paul's imprisonment

- Paul was imprisoned after being falsely accused of taking Trophimus, an Ephesian, into forbidden area of Temple (Acts 21:39-22:22)
- Imprisoned because of his ministry to gentiles

Paul's preferred title

- Prisoner for Christ (although prisoner of Rome)
- Our Titles in ministry (if any) should glorify God, not ourselves!
 - God's servant, commonly used in assemblies ... appropriate & preferred title

Paul's special dispensation (2,3)

Dispensation of Grace

- Paul is chosen by God as special vessel/messenger/steward to release the gospel and mysteries revealed to him (Acts 9:15, 13:47, 22:21, Galatians 2:2,8)
- A great honor that God chose Paul to take His message to gentiles. Peter primarily ministered among the Jews (in Acts)
- The mission and the message was given to Paul. Paul was only a vessel.
 - Same should be true in our ministry

Paul ... a model student (3)

Paul's Teachers

Before conversion (Hebrew scriptures): Rabbi Gamaliel (Acts 22:3)

After conversion: I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel I preached is not of human origin. <u>I did not receive it from any man</u>, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by **revelation from Jesus Christ**. **(Galatians 1:11-12**, NIV)

Paul spent three years in Arabia (Galatians 1:15-20)

Mystery of Christ (4,5)

Not fully revealed in the Old Testament but **now revealed** by apostles and prophets (in church age) (also verse 9)

Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but **now** is made manifest to his saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory (Colossians 1:26,27)

Mystery Details (6)

- □ Converted Gentiles will be **fellow heirs** (along with converted Jews)
- ☐ Gentiles will be members of the same body

Gentiles will be **partakers of the promise** in Christ (all the promises in-Christ, including Holy Spirit (Acts 15:8), blessings of Abraham (Galatians 3:10-14))

(From Ephesians 2:14-16) seen last week Blessed Union of Jews & Gentiles

Jews and Gentiles made One ... By destroying the source of differences

- Broke middle wall of partition
- Enmity between Jews and Gentiles abolished
- Law as a source of enmity/superiority/righteousness removed
- Reconciled Jews & Gentiles unto God in one body (the church)

Unity attained at the Cross. Cross becomes the new focal point, not culture or traditions or law or geography, etc.

Union lead to citizenship, adoption into family, membership to church

ONE IN CHRIST JESUS!

There is neither Jew nor Gentile,
neither slave nor free,
nor is there male and female,
for you are all one in Christ Jesus
(Galatians 3:28, NIV)

OT and NT blessings

Blessing of the OT (to Jews) and Blessings of the Church (NT)

- Israel's blessing material (Deuteronomy 28)
 - Church's blessing spiritual (Ephesians 1:3)

- Israel's calling earthly nation, promised land of Canaan
 - Church's calling heavenly bride, New Jerusalem

Church Age

Church **BEGAN** when the Holy Spirit descended

Acts 2, I Corinthians 12:13

&

ENDS with the Rapture

Paul's effective ministry (8)

Secret of success

- Called by God for ministry (Acts 9)
- **Humility** (least of all saints, 8 & chiefest of sinners, I Timothy 1:15)
- **Dependent** on God's grace and power (7, II Corinthians 12:9-10)

Areas of Focus in Paul's Ministry

- Preach the gospel (Theme: Unsearchable riches of Christ)
- Strengthen saints
- Assist local churches
- ☐ Epistles (Main Topics: Spiritual Blessings, Church, Practical insights)

Purpose of the Mystery (10-13)

To whom should the church reveal the mystery? What must be known by all? What is God's eternal purpose? What gives us Boldness and Access? What is Paul's perspective on his suffering?

Purpose of the mystery (10,11)

To reveal (through the church) the manifold wisdom of God to angelic beings in heavenly realms. Mystery was not revealed to angels

What can we teach angels?

(possible topics ... the mystery of the church, God's plan in redeeming gentiles, God's plan in making sinner into a saint, God's plan in defeating sin/death/Satan at the cross)

• Eternal purpose accomplished through Christ at the cross

Approaching our Heavenly Father

- **Boldness** ... to speak without any fear
- Access ... entrance opened
- Confidence ... knowing He welcomes us and hears us
- Made possible through our faith in Christ

"Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need" (Hebrews 4:16)

Paul's perspective on suffering (13)

- Long-term perspective ... suffering is the path to glory
- External perspective ... it will bless others
- Kingdom perspective ... it will benefit the work of the Kingdom
- Godly perspective ... it is in God's will

Hence Paul could write, we glory in Tribulations (Romans 5:3)
