## God's offer to Solomon (II Chronicles 1:7)

"That night God appeared to Solomon and said to him, "Ask for whatever you want me to give you."

#### Bread/Stone ... Fish/Snake

<sup>11</sup> If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

#### Earthly Fathers versus Heavenly Father

- If evil parents can think of good gifts for children, how much more will our Heavenly father do
- If Heavenly father takes care of the birds, flowers, and the grass, how much more his children (5:26, 29, 30)

# Prayer life of Jesus

Why did Jesus pray? How often did He pray?

### Jesus prayed ... how much more should we?

**Early Morning**: And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed (**Mark 1:35**)

**Evening**: And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone (**Mathew 14:23**)

**Sometimes all night**: He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God (**Luke 6:12**) (before major decision, selecting disciples)

Frequently @ Lonely/quiet places: But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed" (Luke 5:16)

We must have a dedicated time and a quiet place to pray

Pray to enjoy His communion, discover His will, and experience His power

## What motivates us to pray to a living God?

#### God's ability to provide

Is there anything too hard for me?, Jeremiah 32:27

#### His generosity and love

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? Romans 8:32

Idols cannot

provide, love,

know or answer

#### He knows what is best for us

How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! Psalm 139:17

Past experience of answered prayers

# What is the end result of an effective prayer?

## End result of an effective prayer

Divine Inner Peace/Strength/Joy (Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus, Philippians 4:6-7) burdens rolled away (I Peter 5:7, Psalms 55:22), Strengthened (Isaiah 40:31, II Corinthians 12:9) Joy of communion (Psalms 16:11)

God's perfect will is put in motion and accomplished in His perfect time (Could be instantly or later)

# Why do prayers go unanswered?

#### Prayers may go unanswered if:

- 1. Wrong intent (Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts, James 4:3)
- 2. Wrong time (Genesis 2:21, set time; Galatians 4:4. fullness of time)
- 3. No faith (But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering, James 1:6-8, Mathew 21:22, Hebrews 11:6)
- 4. Sin (Your sins have hid his face from you that he will not hear, Isaiah 59:1, Iniquity in heart, Psalms 66:18)
- 5. No persistence (Jeremiah 29:13, Luke 18:7)
- 6. Dishonoring your wife (I Peter 3:7)
- 7. Praying to impress (Hypocrisy, Matthew 6:5), or praying without sincerity (Vain repetitions, 6:7)

### Prayers of the obedient are answered

"And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight"

(I John 3:22)

## When to stop praying?

## When to stop praying?

#### **Continue to Pray until God responds:**

YES NO LATER

(God's response generally confirmed with God's Word and/or circumstances and/or other believers)

#### Choose to Pray in all circumstances

Israelites murmured and complained when faced with trials,

But Moses prayed & God answered

Murmuring/Complaining is not praying

**Choose to Pray in all seasons of life** 

### Prayer in Proverbs

"Two things I ask of you, Lord; do not refuse me before I die:

<sup>8</sup> Keep falsehood and <u>lies far from me;</u> give me neither poverty nor riches, but give me only my daily bread.

<sup>9</sup>Otherwise, I may have too much and disown you and say, 'Who is the Lord?'

Or I may become poor and steal, and so dishonor the name of my God (Proverbs 30:7-9)

## Lord's Model Prayer (6:9-13)

9 **Our Father** which art in heaven, **Hallowed** be thy name. <sup>10</sup> **Thy kingdom** come, **Thy will** be done in earth, as it is in heaven. <sup>11</sup> **Give us** this day our daily bread. <sup>12</sup> And **forgive us** our debts, as we forgive our debtors. <sup>13</sup> And lead us not into temptation, but **deliver us** from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

9 - A personal prayer to a majestic God, our Father, seated in Heaven

9&10: Focus on God (His glory, His Kingdom, His will)

11-13: Focus on our physical and spiritual needs

Should not be just repeated without faith or understanding
