Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, Acts 17:1

#### Author: Paul

(gives credit to co-workers, Timothy and Silas) (Acts 18:1-5, all three present in Corinth)

Time: A.D. 54

Written to: Thessalonian Believers Written from Corinth (after 1 year of planting the church)

Background Reading: Acts 16-17

Themes:

(1) Exhortation to strive for Excellence in Spiritual life

- (2) Encourage the persecuted church
- (3) Blessed hope of Return of Christ

: Thessalonica

Thessalonica, Greece:

Part of Paul's second missionary Journey

Preached Jesus in Thessalonica (Acts 17:1-5)

Facing Jewish opposition, Paul flees for Berea (Acts 17:10)

Jews chased him in Berea & Paul left for Athens (Acts 17)

Paul next went to **Corinth** (Acts 18:11, staying 18 months) ... this letter written from Corinth. Paul faced Jewish opposition in Corinth also. Paul visited Thessalonica later.

: Thessalonica

#### Thessalonica, Greece:

Paul was in Thessalonica for a short time (maybe few weeks or few months). Philippian church practically ministered to Paul (Philippians 4:16)

Despite persecution, Thessalonica church grew healthily.

Paul commends them for their good works and spiritual progress, and

gives them counsel on how to mature further and be a model church/believers.

Silas

## Introduction : Silas

And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God. Acts 15:40 Accompanied Paul during his 2<sup>nd</sup> missionary Journey. Replaced Barnabas, following conflict between Paul & Barnabas over John Mark. (Acts 15:36-40)

With Paul @ Philippi and in Prison where Jailer is saved (Acts 16:12)

also joined Paul in Thessalonica (Acts 17)

: Timothy

Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father was a Greek: (Acts 16:1)

#### Timothy

- Mixed cultural background, Jewish + Greek
- Believing mother, Eunice, with Jewish background and Greek father (most likely unbeliever), Christian grandmother, Lois (II Timothy 1:5)
- Timothy most likely saved during Paul's earlier visit to Lystra (Acts 14:8-20)
- Timothy is mentored by Paul (I Corinthians 4:17)
- Timothy was with Paul in Corinth (Acts 18:5)
- Valuable co-worker in second missionary journey, and later.

### Paul preached CHRIST

#### CHRIST

 From Greek word, *Christos*, and means the 'anointed' or 'chosen' one Hebrew equivalent word – *Mashiach* – Messiah

> CHRIST HAS ARRIVED, BEEN CRUCIFIED/BURIED/RESURRECTED ...and CHRIST IS COMING BACK! But some are still waiting for the Messiah!

- Jesus prophesied as Christ (Psalms 22, Isaiah 53/61)
- Jesus <u>claimed</u> to be Christ (Luke 4:17-21)
- Peter recognized Jesus as Christ (Mathew 16:16)
- Jesus is the anointed one and Messiah that Jews have been waiting for


# Paul's opening greetings

Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ (1)

#### **Grace & Peace**

God's grace leads to Peace with God and with men

## Paul's ministry (2)



Paul is a good example for us to follow if we want to expand the work of the Lord.

To God be the Glory: I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase (I Corinthians 3:6) Lord added to the church daily (Acts 2:47)

## 3 Reasons for thanks (3)

### WORK OF FAITH (fruit of faith = good works)

#### LABOR OF LOVE (labor prompted by love)

PATIENCE OF HOPE (endurance/patience inspired by hope in the return of Christ)

And now abideth faith, hope and love (I Corinthians 13:13) Is it Love for God or Love for people or both?

Do we love our ministry more than we love God or His people?

What is the Motivation for our ministry?

For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.<sup>15</sup> And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again (II Corinthians 5:14-15)

## Election ... God's choice of his people

For he **chose** us in Him before the foundation of the world (Ephesians 1:4)

No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day (John 6:44)


For thou art an holy people unto the Lord thy God: the Lord thy God hath **chosen** thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. (Deuteronomy 7:6)

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## Gospel Work (5) & Satan's work (!)

Evangelist preaches the <u>Word</u> Word is heard and <u>received</u> Conviction brought by the <u>power of the Holy Spirit</u> <u>Assurance</u> of sins forgiven

Satan makes us to "doubt" that assurance



Do you have the blessed assurance?

For our gospel came not unto you in <u>word</u> only, but also in power, and in the <u>Holy Ghost</u>, and in much <u>assurance</u>; (5) <u>Word</u>: So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17)

<u>Holy Spirit</u>: And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin (John 16:8)

Assurance: For I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. (II Timothy 1:12)

Impact of gospel (6-10) Affliction came (persecution) but believers did not lose Faith & Joy ... Joy during trials!

Became Followers of the Lord (and Paul)

Good example to all, and their testimony spread far and wide (7,8)

Life was Transformed (9-10)

Saved from Wrath to come (10) (Romans 5:9)

How has gospel impacted your life?

Paul's call to follow him Brethren, be followers together of me (Philippians 3:17)

Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ

(I Corinthians 11:1)

### Should church leaders exhort congregation to be "followers of them"?

## The Transformed Life (9-10)

Turned to God from Idols (past, work of faith)

Serving the living God (present, labor of love)

Waiting for His return (future, patience of hope)
