

# 1. Paul's successful Gospel Ministry

Chosen by God to deliver the gospel for the glory of God

Thirteen Epistles of sound teachings

**PAUL** 

Genuine Love for Lost

Worked Hard
Willing to suffer for Christ

What will be "success" in gospel ministry?

### How Gospel works

(1 Thessalonians 1:5)

**Evangelist preaches the Word** 

Word is heard and received

Conviction brought by the power of the Holy Spirit

**Assurance** of sins forgiven & eternal life

Souls saved and <u>added</u> to the Church (Acts 2:37-47)

Satan makes us to "doubt" all of the above, especially assurance of forgiveness

## Effective gospel leads to the Transformed Life (1 Thess. 1:9-10)

Turned to God from Idols

(past, work of faith)

Serving the living God


(present, labor of love)

Waiting for His return

(future, patience of hope)



## Paul's successful model for church ministry: Preach. Plant. Pray. Progress (1 Thessalonians. 1:2)



### Every church needs a Paul ... a mother, father, mentor

(I Thessalonians 2)

As a nursing mother, gentle and nurturing (7)

As a father, exhorted, comforted, and challenged (11)

As a mentor, trained Timothy & others

### Power behind Paul's ministry ... Prayer & Grace of God

Paul's model prayer for all preachers and evangelists (II Thessalonians, 3:1-2)

### Word of God (gospel) may **flow** uninterrupted

Word may be proclaimed for **His glory** 

He may be **delivered** from unreasonable and wicked men

# Paul's Message for afflicted church

Trials, Afflictions, Persecutions are part of believer's life designed to bring spiritual maturity.

Without such teaching, believers will be confused, question or even reject their faith during hard times.

(I Thess. 3:3-4)



# Secret of blessings in our life

### Discover God's will

### God's will

(I Thessalonians 4:3)

God expects holiness in all areas of our life:

Sight

Speech

Thoughts

Hearing

Actions

2. Progressive (on-going) sanctification

# What if you chose to disobey?


(I Thessalonians 4:8)

### RETURN OF CHRIST




### **RAPTURE**

Anti Christ Revealed

7-year Tribulation starts

#### **Second Coming**

- 1. Armagaddon,
- 2. AntiChrist thrown into the lake of fire
- 3. Satan bound for 1,000 years

7-years after rapture

After 1,000-year Messianic rule

Satan thrown into the lake of fire

All unbelievers resurrected and face White Throne Judgement &

cast into lake of fire (Revelation 20:15)

### Appointment with God

For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ (I Thessalonians 5:9)

#### **Believer's Appointment**

- Not to wrath of God but to salvation
- Not to separation but to be in God's presence for ever
- Made possible by the death of Christ on the cross
- Assurance of eternal Security for believers

#### **Unbeliever's Appointment**

Unbeliever's fate will be wrath of God and eternal separation from God

#### BENEDICTION

Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with all of you. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all

#### **Peace**

- He is the price of Peace (Isaiah 9:6)
- He gives perfect peace when we remain focused on Him (Isaiah 26:3)
- He gives peace in the midst of storms (Mark 4:39)
- The Lord will bless his people with peace (Psalms 29:11)
