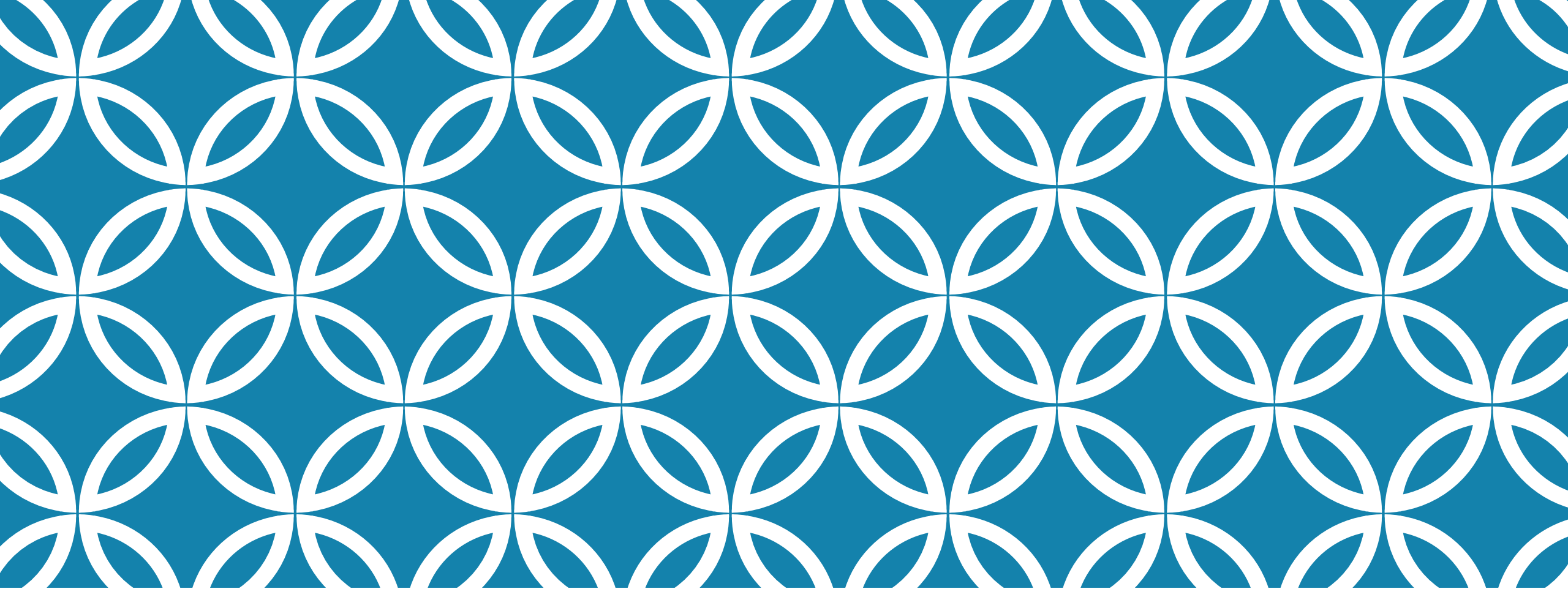

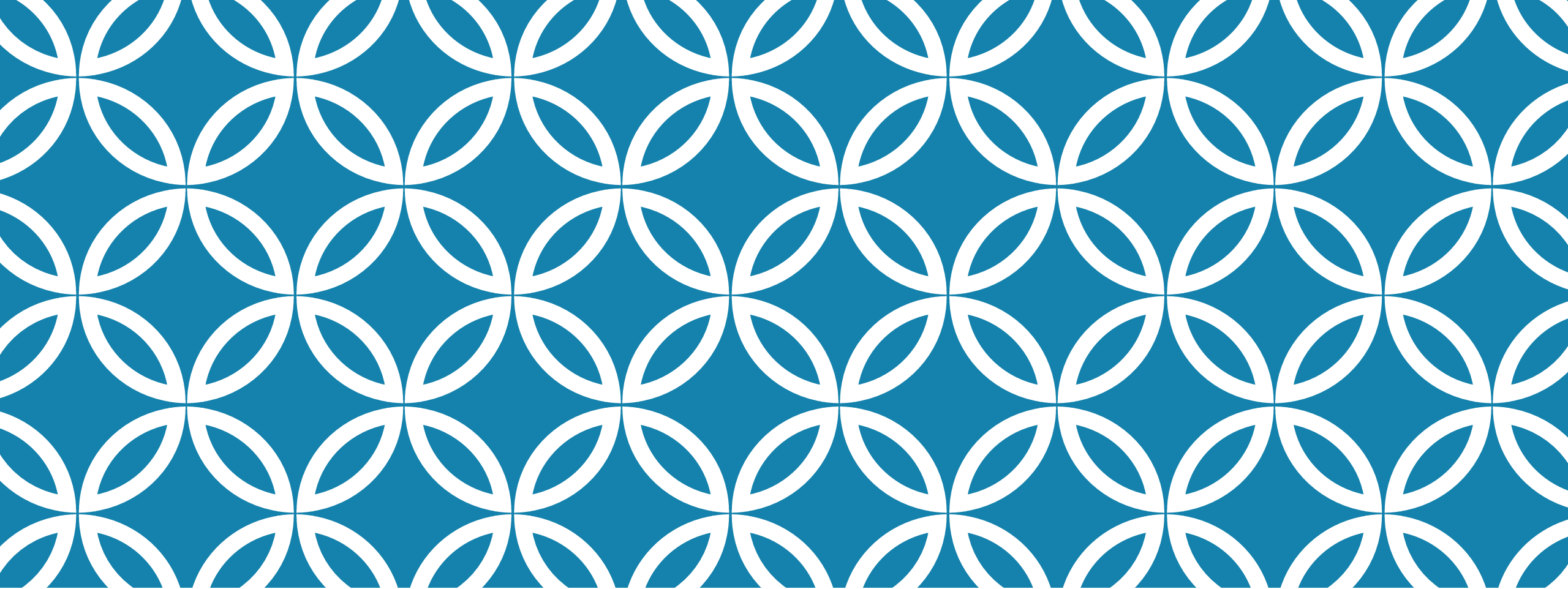

# THE ASSEMBLY

Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them.

<sup>2</sup> And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

<sup>3</sup> And they stood up in their place, and read in the book of the law of the Lord their God one fourth part of the day; and another fourth part they confessed, and worshipped the Lord their God.

# GATHERED TO REPENT

ch.8 First day of 7<sup>th</sup> month:

Two days to read & understand God's Word  
Seven days - festival of tabernacles

On 24<sup>th</sup> day of 1<sup>st</sup> month

ch.9 Gathered again

fasted, sackcloth, dust on heads (symbolic  
of humility and intent to confess)

Why mourn so soon after celebrating?

# GATHERED TO SEPERATE

Church is an ‘exclusive’ community ... a called-out group

## A private confession & worship experience

(strangers not allowed). Israelites lineage separated from all foreigners

Confessed their sins and iniquities of fathers (sinful heritage)

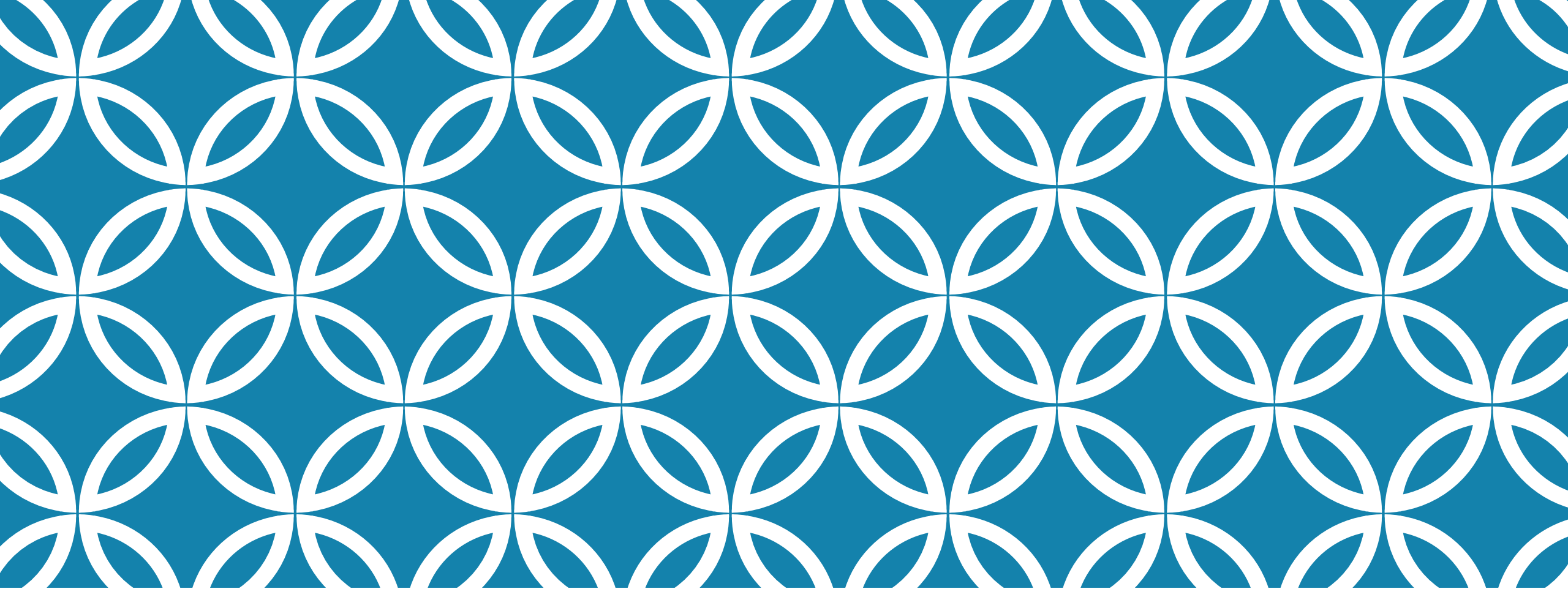
- What is Sin? – transgression of the law (I John 3:4)

**Ezra 10:11** Now therefore make confession unto the Lord God of your fathers, and do his pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives. **II Corinthians 6:17** “Be ye separate”

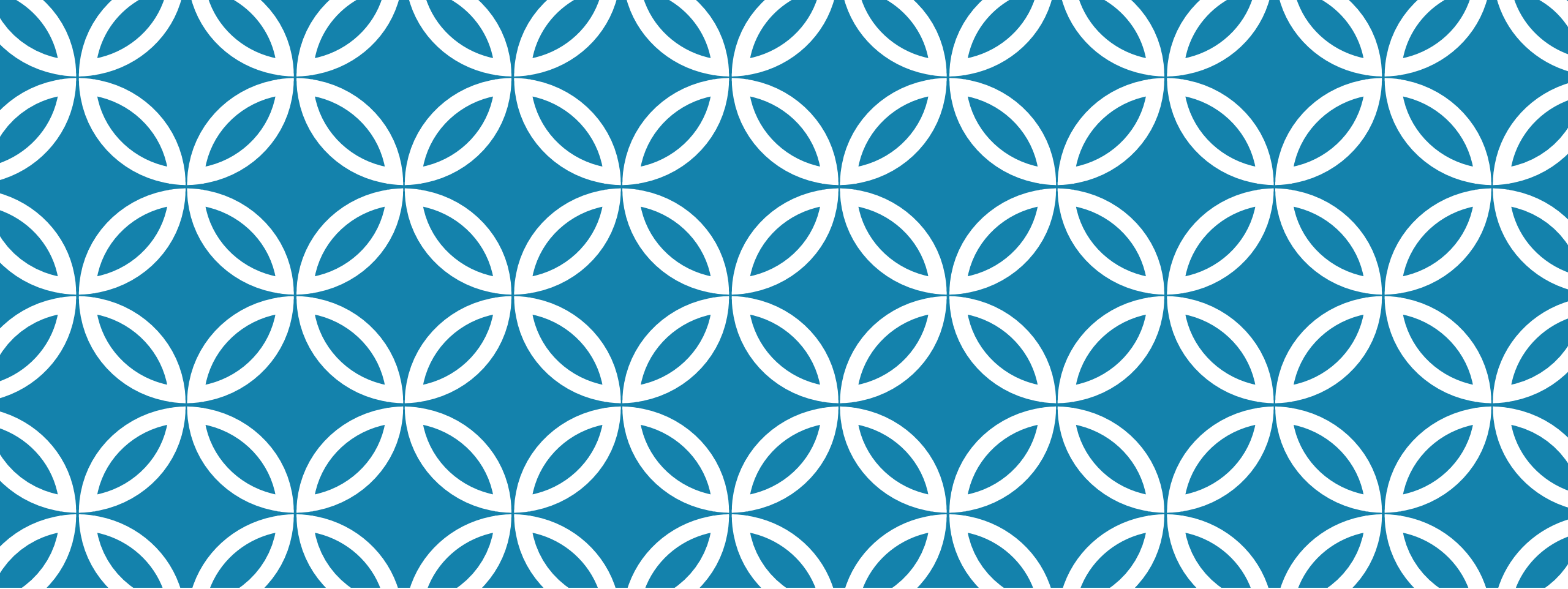

# REPENTANCE

**Repentance** is more than feeling sorry/regret for your sins

Repentance is **commitment to Change** (U-Turn) and resolve to not repeat the same sins

**True repentance will lead to revival**

Evidenced by Changed lives, true worship, and fruits

**Mathew 3:8** Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

No fruit ==> No genuine repentance

# WORSHIP THE ONLY TRUE AND LIVING GOD

**Isaiah 45:18** For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the Lord; and there is none else.

**I Timothy 2:5** For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

**Psalms 86:10** For thou art great, and doest wondrous things: thou art God alone.

**Isaiah 43:10** before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.

# IDOLS ARE NOT GODS

## Psalm 115: 3

But our God is in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased. <sup>4</sup> Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

<sup>5</sup> They have mouths, but they speak not: eyes have they, but they see not: <sup>6</sup> They have ears, but they hear not: noses have they, but they smell not: <sup>7</sup> They have hands, but they handle not: feet have they, but they walk not: neither speak they through their throat.

<sup>8</sup> They that make them are like unto them; so is every one that trusteth in them.

<sup>7</sup> Thou art the Lord the God, who didst choose Abram, and broughtest him forth out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gavest him the name of Abraham; <sup>8</sup> And foundest his heart faithful before thee, and madest a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Girgashites, to give it, I say, to his seed, and hast performed thy words; for thou art righteous:

<sup>9</sup> And didst see the affliction of our fathers in Egypt, and heardest their cry by the Red sea; <sup>10</sup> And shewedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt proudly against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as it is this day.

<sup>11</sup> And thou didst divide the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors thou threwest into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters. <sup>12</sup> Moreover thou leddest them in the day by a cloudy pillar; and in the night by a pillar of fire, to give them light in the way wherein they should go.

<sup>13</sup> Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments: <sup>14</sup> And madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, and commandedst them precepts, statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant:

<sup>15</sup> And gavest them bread from heaven for their hunger, and broughtest forth water for them out of the rock for their thirst, and promisedst them that they should go in to possess the land which thou hadst sworn to give them.

# #1 GOD & ABRAHAM (7,8)

<sup>7</sup> THOU ART THE LORD THE GOD, WHO  
DIDST CHOOSE ABRAM, AND BROUGHTEST  
HIM FORTH OUT OF UR OF THE  
CHALDEES, AND GAVEST HIM THE NAME  
OF ABRAHAM; <sup>8</sup> AND FOUNDEST HIS HEART  
FAITHFUL BEFORE THEE, AND MADEST A  
COVENANT WITH HIM TO GIVE THE LAND  
OF THE CANAANITES, THE HITTITES, THE  
AMORITES, AND THE PERIZZITES, AND THE  
JEBUSITES, AND THE GIRGASHITES, TO  
GIVE IT, I SAY, TO HIS SEED, AND HAST

## Deliverance

**Exodus 20:**<sup>2</sup> I am the Lord thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

## ONLY GOD CAN DELIVER US FROM THE BONDAGE OF SIN

**Galatians 1:4** Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

**Colossians 1:13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son

<sup>12</sup> MOREOVER THOU LEDDEST  
THEM IN THE DAY BY A CLOUDY  
PILLAR; AND IN THE NIGHT BY A  
PILLAR OF FIRE, TO GIVE THEM  
LIGHT IN THE WAY WHEREIN  
THEY SHOULD GO.

**Exodus 13:21** And the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night: <sup>22</sup> He took not away the pillar of the cloud by day, nor the pillar of fire by night, from before the people.

## SABBATH

### God's Provision for Physical Rest and Spiritual Renewal

**Exodus 20:8** Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.  
<sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup> But the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:

*Take a break from worldly work on Sundays and be spiritually renewed*

# #6 GOD WHO PROVIDES (MIRACULOUSLY) (15)

<sup>15</sup> AND GAVEST THEM BREAD  
FROM HEAVEN FOR THEIR  
HUNGER, AND BROUGHTEST  
FORTH WATER FOR THEM OUT  
OF THE ROCK FOR THEIR THIRST,  
AND PROMISEDST THEM THAT  
THEY SHOULD GO IN TO POSSESS  
THE LAND WHICH THOU HADST  
SWORN TO GIVE THEM.

[Mathew 6:33](#) But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you

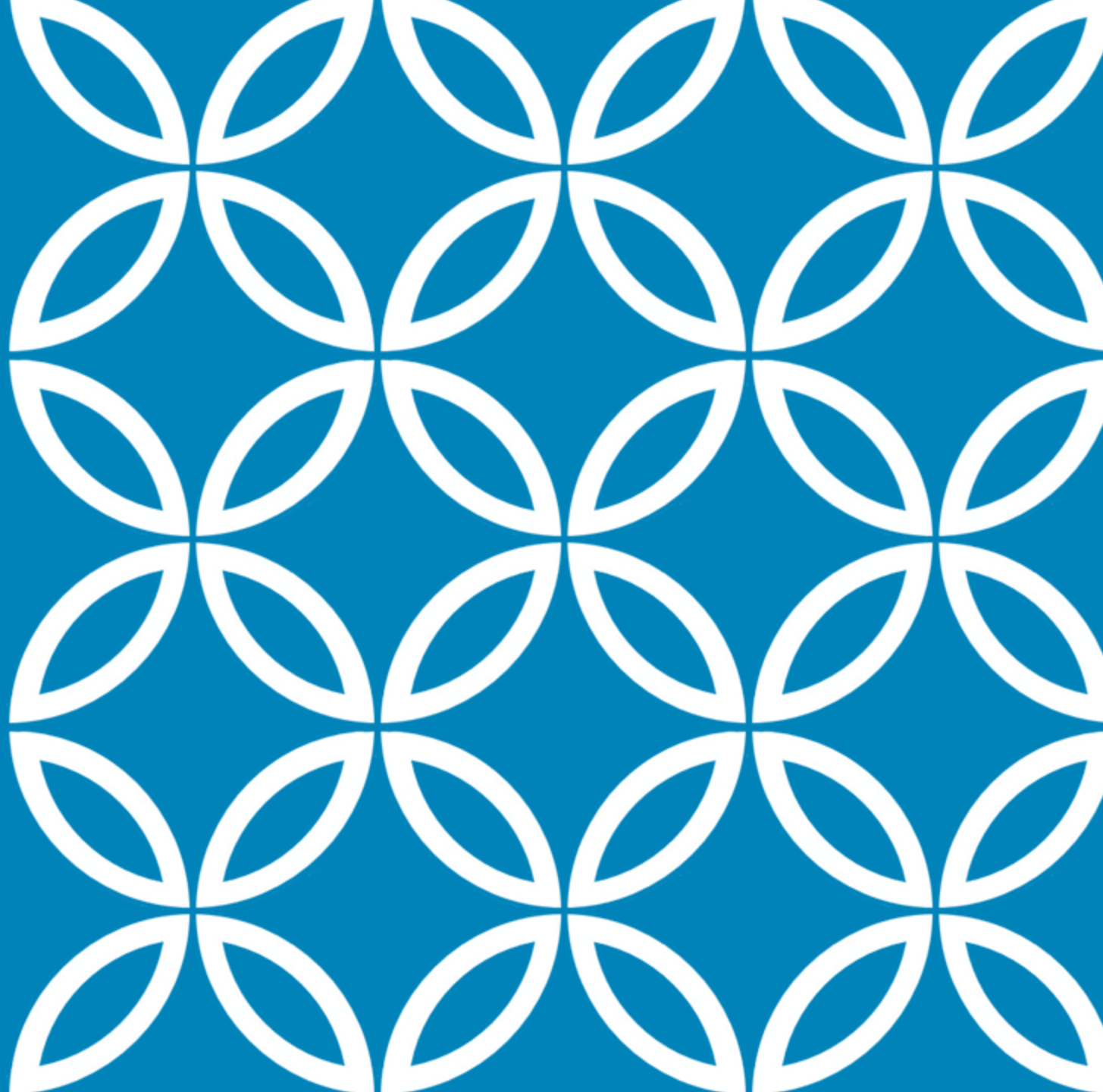

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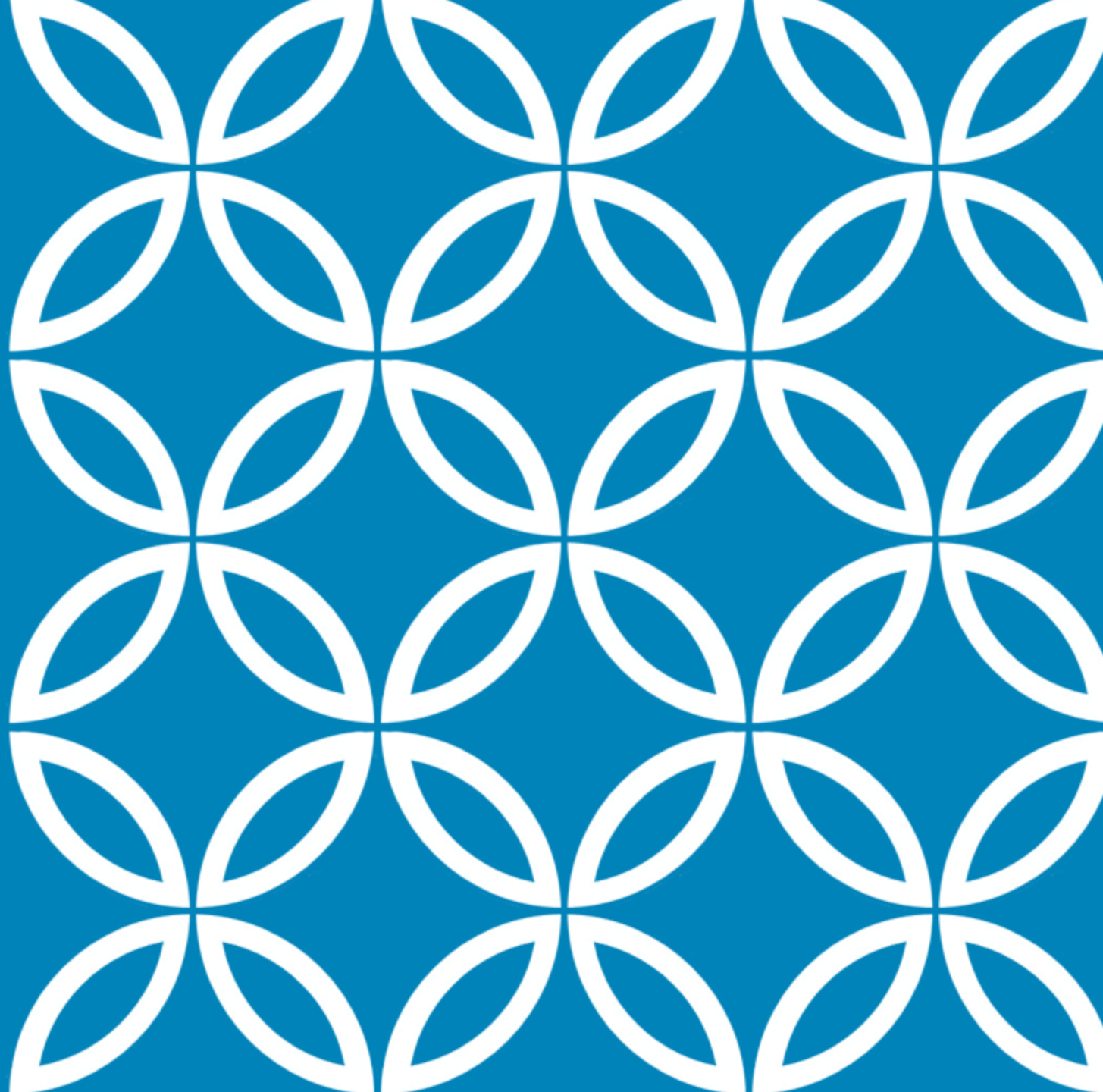
