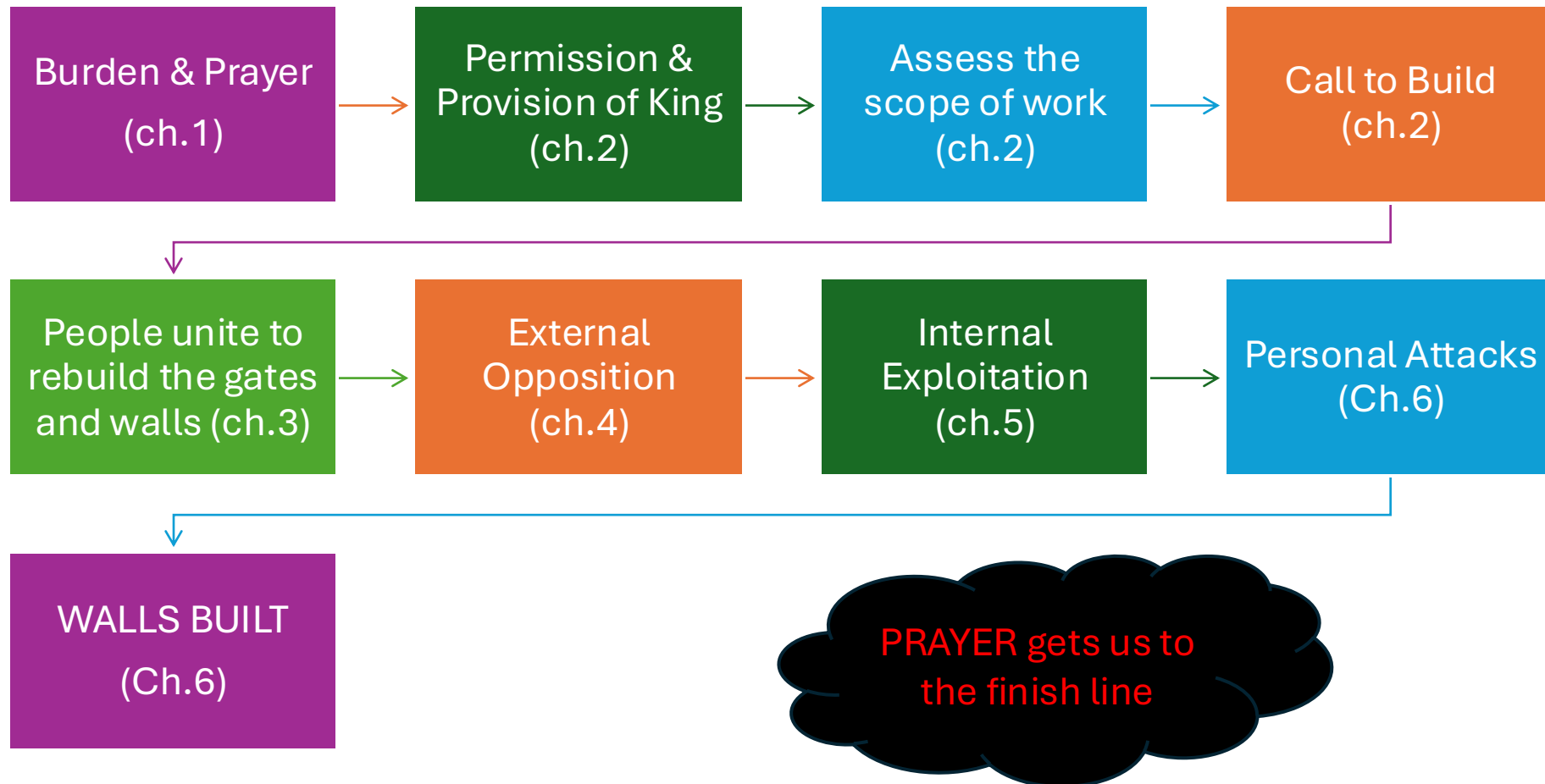

The Call of Nehemiah:

Rebuild the broken Jerusalem walls



Chapter 1

Nehemiah **ENQUIRES**

about the condition of
the Jews in Jerusalem

- Suffering due to famine, Slavery & Oppression
- Walls are broken & Gates burned with fire

Nehemiah
REACTS
with sorrow,
weeping, fasting
& prayer

Nehemiah
PRAYS

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Nehemiah's (Unreasonable) request to the king (2:4-8)

GRANTED!

1. Send me to Judah
2. Release me from my duty as a cup bearer for unspecified time (went away for 12 years!)
3. Timber for building walls & residence
4. Security while traveling

Purpose: to rebuild the broken walls

- Not a reasonable request as it does not benefit the king. The request also goes against the previous ruling of the king to 'not build' 13 years back (Ezra 4:21)
- **Proverbs 21:1** The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

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Nehemiah's call to build (2:17-20)

LET US RISE & BUILD so that we will not be a reproach. Hand of God is upon me

RESPONSE of people They strengthened their hands for this good work

Tobiah & Sanballat opposed & discouraged

But Nehemiah not discouraged or distracted. He reinforces his confidence in God

**“The God of heaven, he will prosper us;
therefore, we his servants will arise and build”**


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Inspection of Gates (ch.3)

- GATES & WALLS need to be repaired. Security compromised even if one gate or portion of wall is broken.
- Nehemiah mentions 12 gates (10 in chapter 3)
- Nehemiah personally inspected the gates and walls to understand the scope of work (2:11-16).



ch.4

The POWER OF PRAYER to confront challenges




Progress on rebuilding efforts triggers opposition from outsiders:

- Sanballat & Tobiah (mockery)
- + Arabs and Ashdodites (conspiracy to launch surprise attack on jews)

Physical exhaustion threatens progress

All oppositions and challenges “overcome” through the **power of prayer + action**

Workers encouraged and equipped to fight the enemy. Enemies withdraw! Work continues.



Ch.5 (internal) Exploitation of poor


Money needed for food and taxes. Rich exploited through high interest rates.

Nehemiah angered by lack of unity and love among Jews.


Nehemiah confronts the rich. Rich agree to return and restore. Took an oath to confirm


FIRST WORSHIP in Nehemiah

- prompted by repentance, love & unity among people of God




Nehemiah's wise response to challenges




- **External Opposition:** Prayer + Action (ch.4)
 - **Physical Exhaustion:** Encouragement (ch.4)
 - **Internal Opposition:** Confront boldly based on truth (ch.5)
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Ch. 6 Personal attacks on Nehemiah, and Nehemiah's wise response. Work not disrupted or delayed.

Deceptive invitation to pause work and meet (1-4)
(invitation rejected 4 times)



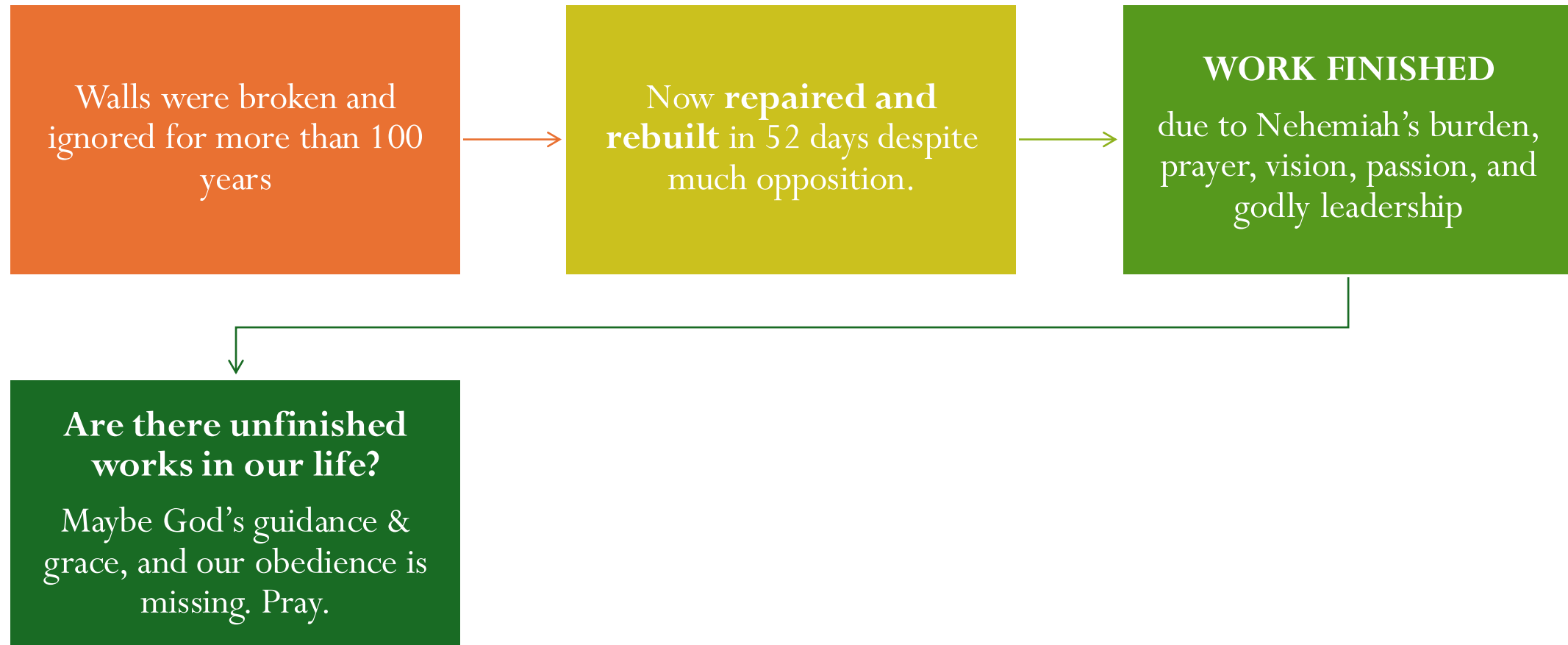
Slander & Lies (5-9)
(confronted the lies, and committed in prayer)



False prophecy to sin against God (10-14)
(commits in prayer and is not scared for his life)

Ch. 6

Wall Finished in 52 days (he prayed longer than 52 days!)

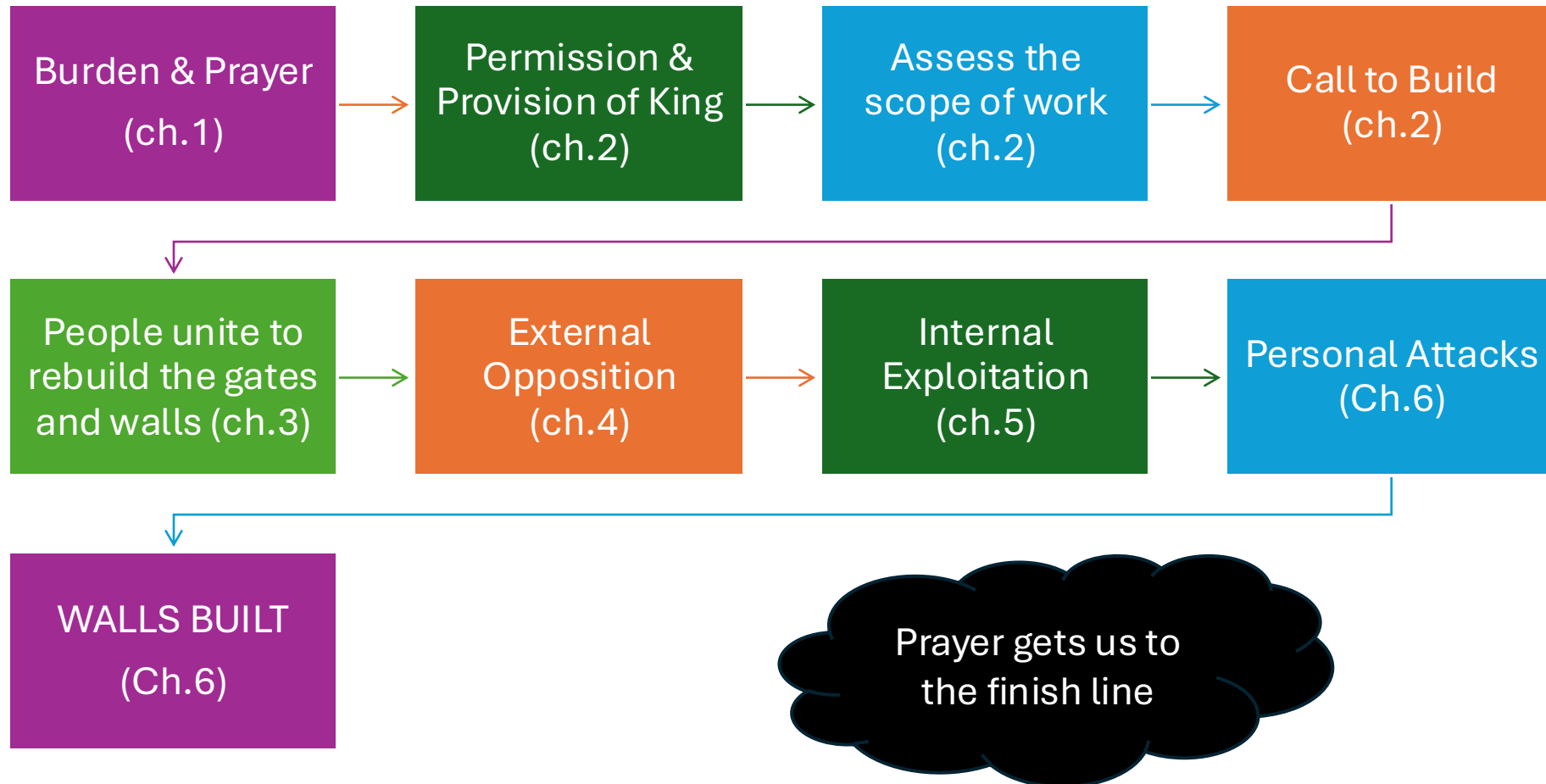

THE DIVINE Call of Nehemiah:

Rebuild the broken Jerusalem walls



FIRST STEPS after building the walls (ch.7)



SECURITY: Appointed gatekeepers with additional support provided by singers, and Levites (assistant to the priests).

GOVERNANCE: Two leaders appointed - faithful men that feared God
(authority delegated to Hanani and Hananiah)

Populate the City
(census of around 50,000) (also ch.11)

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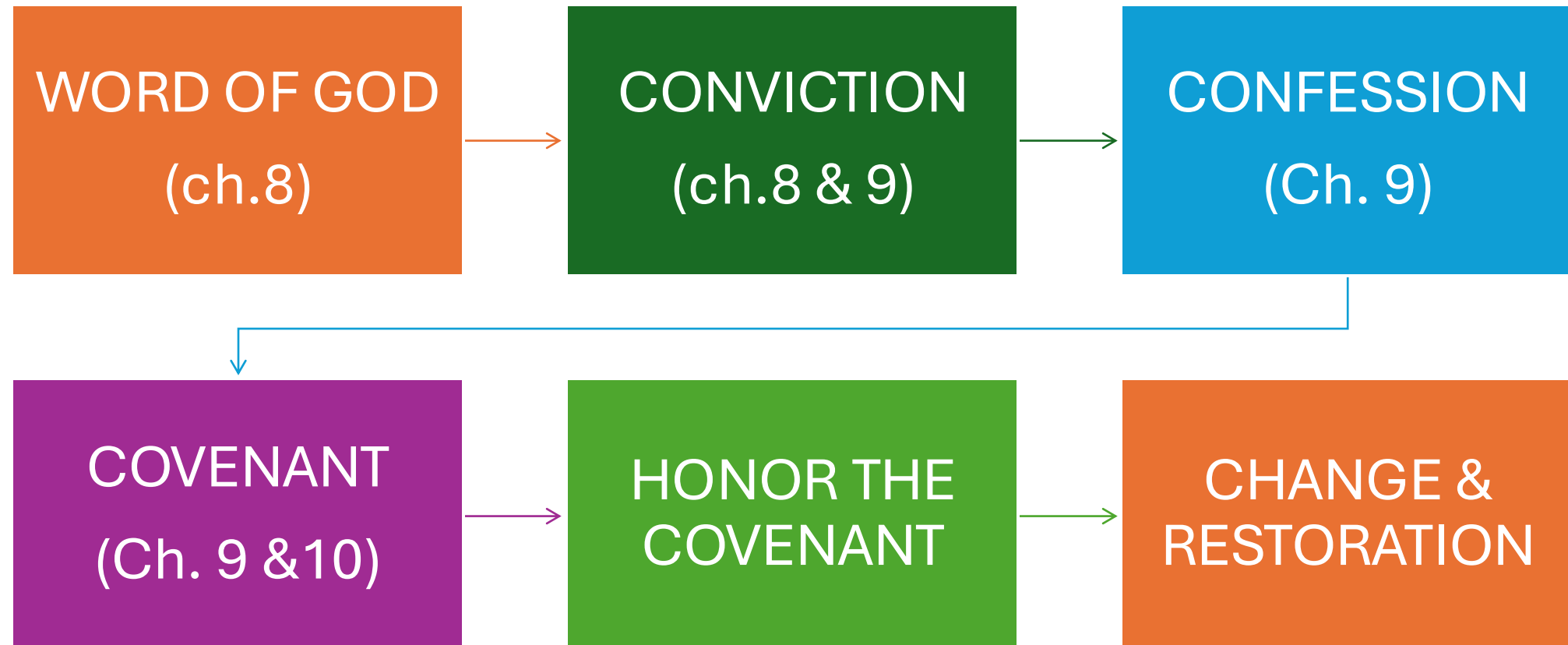

The proven path to spiritual restoration



Spiritual REVIVAL BEGINS with the Word of God (ch.8)



Longest prayer: Reasons to worship & Confess (ch.9)

Theme:

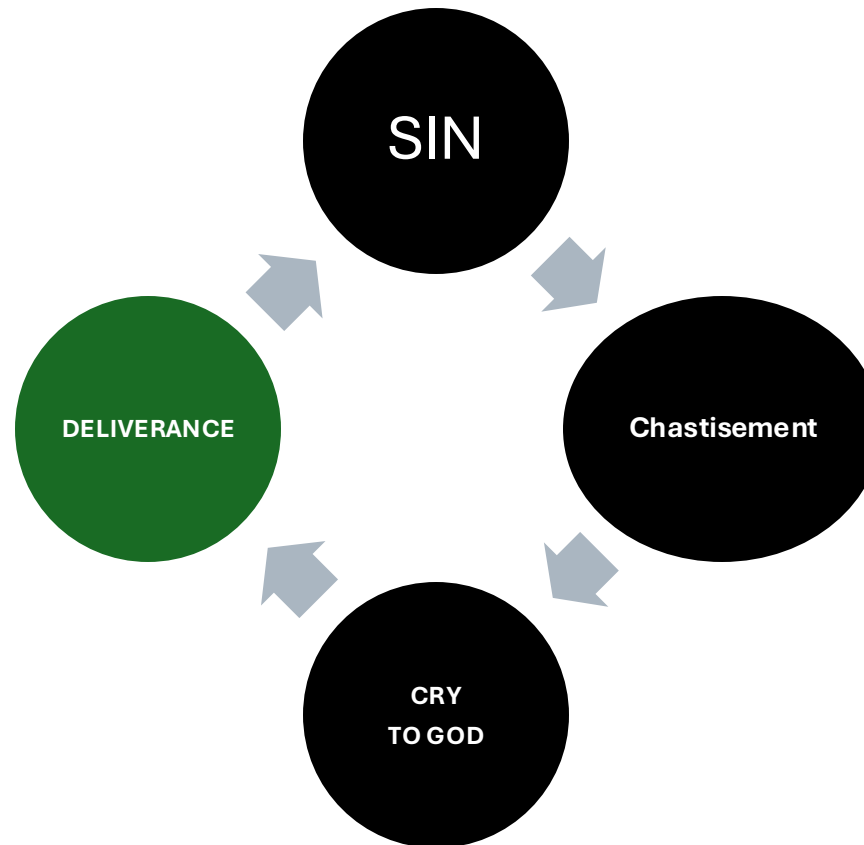
God's faithfulness & Man's unfaithfulness

Reasons to Praise (5-6) (eternal God, exalted God, creator, sustainer, worshipped by heavenly hosts)

Historical Perspective on God's faithfulness: Miraculous deliverance, provisions, guidance, victory, laws (7-15)

God's faithfulness despite man's rebellion and rejection (16-36)

Ignored Sabbath
(took steps to stop
commerce)

Unequally Yoked
and loss of Jewish
identity (warn and
renew covenant)

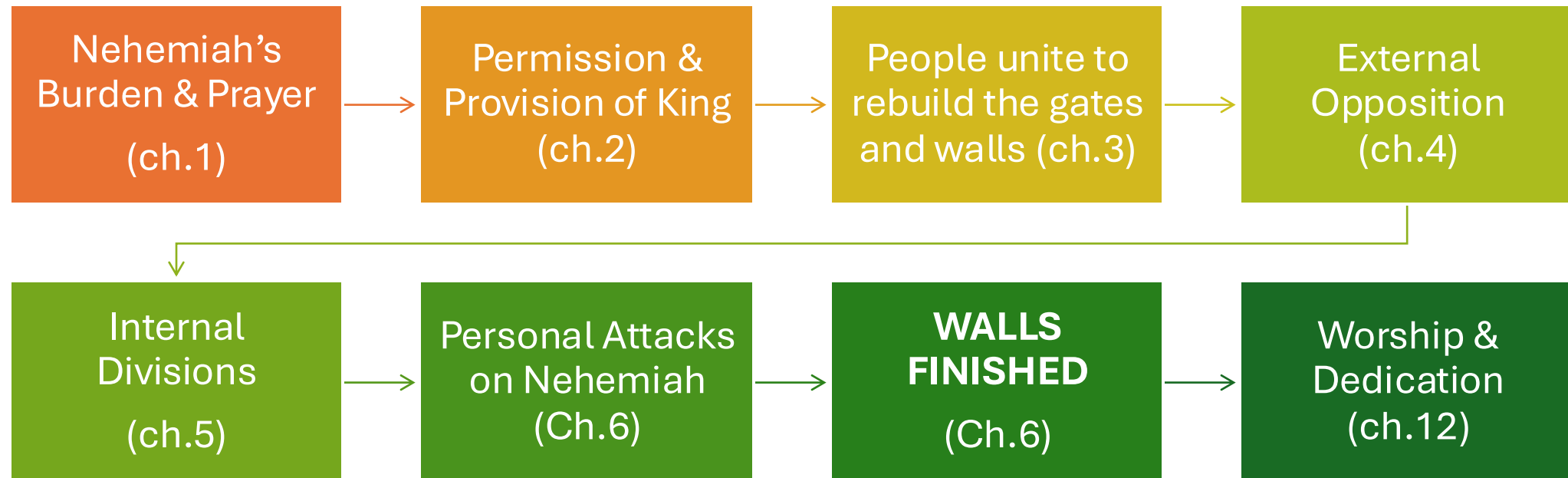

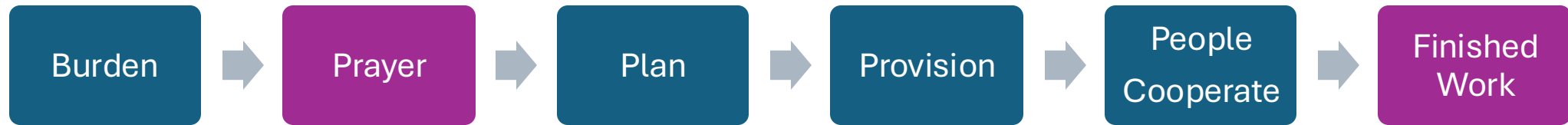
Nehemiah's Vision + Passion + God's grace lead to The Building of walls of Jerusalem & Restoration of Divine Order & Worship
